<i>Responsibility</i>	<p>The student:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• completes homework• submits work on time• attends academic assistance when needed• takes ownership of academic results• contacts teacher in a timely manner about missed work• applies effective study strategies
<i>Organization</i>	<p>The student:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• manages time, space, and materials for effective learning• comes to class punctually and prepared to work• makes a plan to ensure work is done on time• uses appropriate scheduling tools
<i>Independent Work</i>	<p>The student:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• uses work time effectively• follows instructions with minimal supervision• sets academic goals and works to meet them• tries to solve problems before seeking assistance
<i>Collaboration</i>	<p>The student:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• works well with others• meets commitments when working in a group• does his or her fair share• listens actively• supports the contributions of others• shares resources and information with group members
<i>Initiative</i>	<p>The student:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• starts on new tasks willingly• asks for clarification or assistance when needed• looks for opportunities to learn more• advocates for self• offers ideas in class• approaches work in creative and innovative ways
<i>Self-Regulation</i>	<p>The student:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• perseveres• uses technology appropriately and avoids distractions• maintains focus in class• exhibits emotional control• does not interfere with the learning of others
